2016 HIGHLIGHTS

- The support of the State Railway of Thailand creates a unique hosting of the events at Makkasan Airport Rail Link Expo Hall from 1-2 December 2016.
- SmartRail Asia will co-locate with the recently launched Transport Infrastructure Asia expo, occupying both Expo Halls of the new state-of-the -art Airport Rail Link venue at the interchange station with Petchaburi MRT.
- SmartRail Asia 2016, co-located with Transport Infrastructure Asia 2016, is set to double in size as it attracts an Asian wide audience covering the full spectrum of rail professionals and infrastructure specialists.

INTRODUCTION

SmartRail Asia consistently attracts an audience of over 2,000 industry professionals to the exhibition and conference. The last event staged its largest ever edition to date and gathered high-level attendees from throughout Asia. In total 44 countries visited the event in Bangkok with representation of over 40 operators from the region.

Exhibits in the combined events include the full spectrum of rail and metro infrastructure and technology with last year's exhibitors and their representatives numbering 188 companies to include Bombardier, Mitsubishi, Siemens, Italian-Thai Development, Sumitomo, State Railway of Thailand, Japan Railway East and Schneider for example.



AN ASIAN MARKETPLACE

International participation at SmartRail Asia is high with 29.1% of attendees at the previous event being from overseas, Asian trade visitors were led in number by Malaysia and Singapore, followed by China, Japan, Korea, India, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Myanmar, Philippines, Indonesia, Saudi Arabia, Vietnam, Oman, Cambodia and Pakistan, Laos, Qatar, Bangladesh, Macau, Kuwait, Iran and Sri Lanka.

Thailand was ranked as the most important market in Asia by the international suppliers with 92.5% identifying it as the key market, this was followed by Malaysia with 69.75%, Singapore with 65.3%, Vietnam with 63%, Indonesia, China and India with 61.8%, the Philippines on 60% and Laos Cambodia and Myanmar on 53.7%*.

The majority of trade visitors attend the exhibition to identify new business opportunities, to meet new suppliers and to meet new clients. An impressive 35.4% of trade visitors to the SmartRail Asia 2015 were rail and metro operators and 10.1% of the buyers attending the event had budgets of over US\$75million*.

The SmartRail Asia Conference alongside the exhibition brought together decision makers to discuss strategic goals, share best practice and ensure the continued development of the Asian rail community. Key speakers sharing their success strategies at the show included the State Railway of Thailand, MRTA, Land Transport Authority of Singapore, SMRT, Prasarana Malaysia Behad, Manila Metro Rail Transit System, Ministry of Transportation and Communication of Taiwan, Malaysian Express Rail Link, Indian Ministry of Railways, Cambodia Railways, ARL, BTS and Mumbai Metro One.


